I came across a quote by Philip Yancey the other day:

He simply said, "Jesus remember me," and Jesus promised, "Today you will be with me in paradise." It was another shocking reminder that grace does not depend on what we have done for God but rather what God has done for us.

Thanks for being a community of grace that accepts each other and accepts those who are new to our community of faith. Let us honor our diversity. And may this be a year where we grow in our ability to listen well to each other even as we allow ourselves to be stretched to look at things in new ways.
